How to reenrol for 2019

1. Receive a form with your child's ideal class type circled
2. Circle and preference with numbers your preferred class times for the new year
3. Return this form to our Member Services Team or a GfA coach
4. You will receive an email stating which class you have successfully enrolled in

FAQ

How do I make sure all of my athletes are enrolled in sessions at the same time?

If you have more than one athlete and you would like them during the same time period, please indicate this by stapling the forms together or making a written note with the full names of each child.

Can my younger child participate in the older 'Youth' classes so that they can be with their sibling/friend? (or vice versa)

No, classes are scheduled so that the older athletes can fill the later times in the gym so that there is more space for younger athletes in the earlier sessions.

There is some overlap in the late afternoon sessions so that families with different aged children can come at the same time.

Can my child participate in a lower ability level class so that they can be with a friend?

Yes, it is allowable that athletes participate in a lower ability level class, however be aware that the class may not be teaching the progressions needed for the athlete to continue to be challenged/improve their gymnastics.

Can my child participate in a higher ability level class so that they can be with a friend?

No, athletes must stay in an ability level that ensures they have done the appropriate progressions in order to learn new skills safely.

Can my child participate in Gym for All competitions?

Athletes that are enrolling in a Junior 3 or Youth 3 class are invited to enrol in an additional competition class. Due to a very high volume of athletes, we cannot offer this opportunity to any other groups at the moment. We believe that this opportunity also provides incentive for athletes to improve their gymnastics to qualify for a Junior/Youth 3 class.
